

Senior Pennant Rules and Conditions of Play

Format

1. The teams will be made up of 4 players per team
2. Players to play in handicap index order: i.e. lowest handicapped golfer plays No1 etc.
3. A Professional is only to replace a No 1 and must play at No1 position.
4. 18 holes of singles matchplay with 2 four ball best ball matches run concurrently.
 - a. Four ball pairings will consist of a team's number 1 & 2, 3 & 4.
 - b. Both singles and four balls to be gross matchplay formats.
5. 1 point shall be awarded for each singles and four ball match won. A half point shall be awarded for any match that is halved. A total of 6 points per match will be available.
6. The team which wins the most match points will be awarded 2 points. If a team match finishes all square, each team will receive 1 point.
7. At the completion of the round robin if teams are tied on match points, a count back for the standings will be decided by the following in order:
 - a. Total number of singles matches won
 - b. Total number of four ball matches won
 - c. Total number of holes won
 - d. The result of the match between the two sides in round robin play.If still tied the placings shall be decided by lot.
8. Playoffs after round robin
 - 1 plays 2 for 1st & 2nd place
 - 3 play 4 for 3rd & 4th place
 - 5 play 6 for 5th & 6th place
9. In the event of a tied match in the play –offs the number 1's shall play in a sudden death play-off on holes as determined by the match convenor.
10. Entry fee shall be \$30 per player.
